Long Beach City College Offers Students Access to Affordable Training for Pharmacy Technician Jobs

What: Long Beach City College (LBCC) announces immediate openings for affordable health care training starting June 4, 2013. LBCC partners with Boston Reed, a national education provider, to offer short-term, affordable health care training programs that prepare students for job opportunities in the growing allied health industry.
